LIBRARY MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

The Library uses the computer based AMLIB Library Management System to run most of its operations such as borrowing and returning of books.

BORROWING STEPS:

1. Identify your book of interest by searching the OPAC Database
2. Note down the call number of the book and Go to the shelves/stack area where you pick the book
3. Present your **bar-coded** students ID and the book to the staff at the issue desk.
4. Ensure that the return date has been stamped
5. Clear with the security personnel at the exit



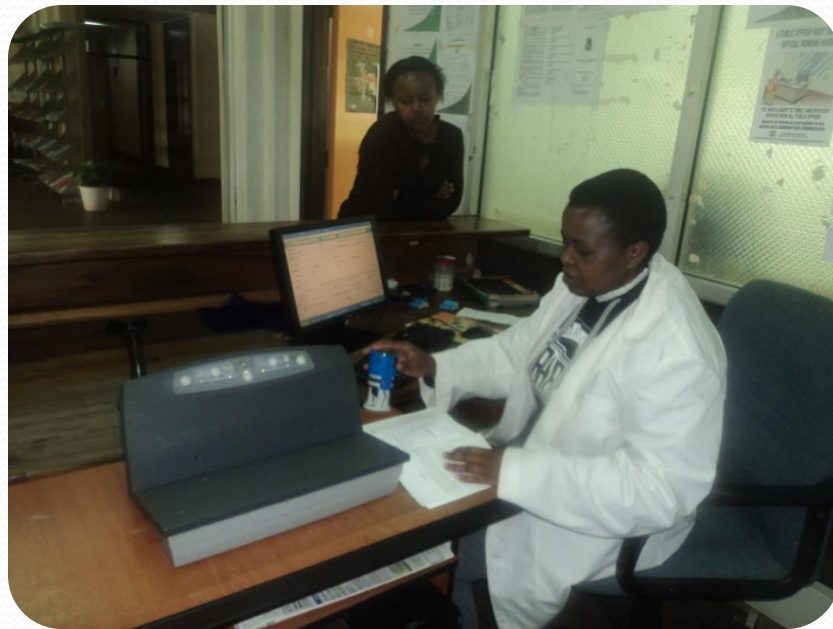

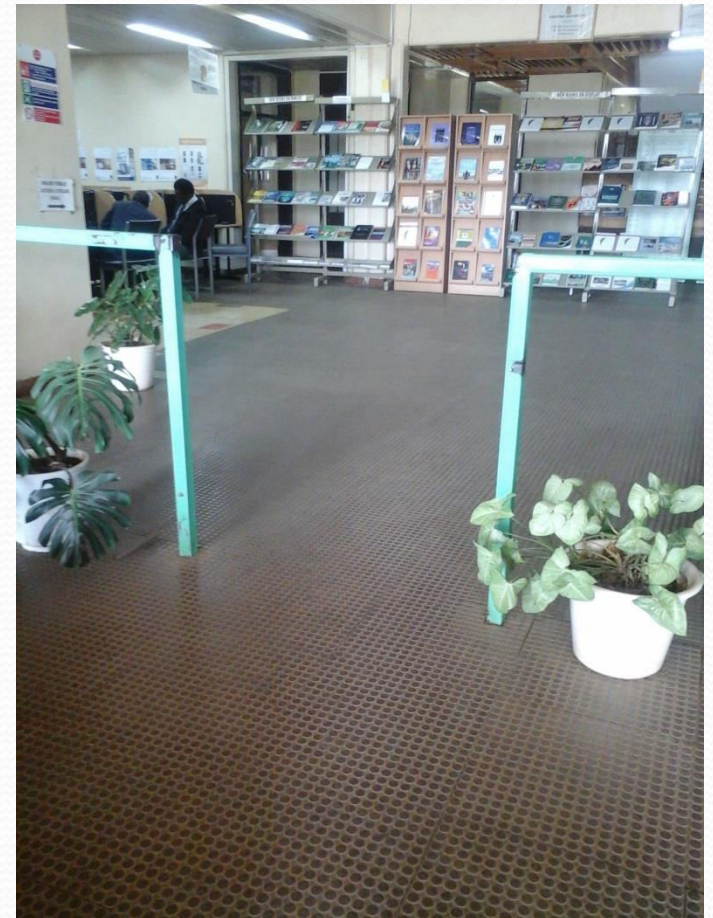

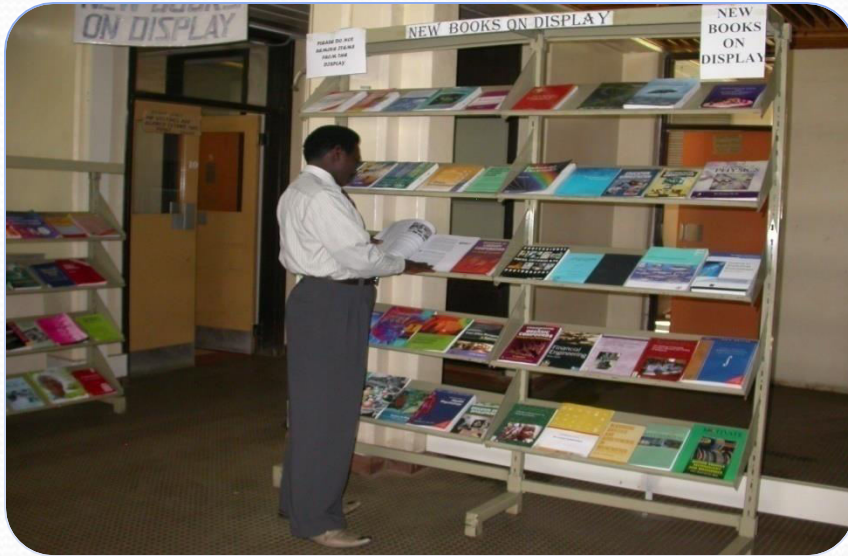
